Funding for establishing a new Town of Bolton Comprehensive Plan is provided using a Smart Growth Grant from the New York State Department of State, contract C1002328. Smart growth is an approach to community planning that integrates economic, equity, environmental and energy principles to facilitate a livable sustainable community.

Going forward after this hearing, the CPC will be expected to refer a proposed Comprehensive Plan to the Town Board. The review process for the proposed comprehensive plan is expected to continue into 2025. As part of the review and approval of a proposed comprehensive plan, the Town Board will also conduct a hearing on the Comprehensive Plan.
