

Village of Macedon Voter-Initiated Dissolution Plan Potential Timeline	
	MAXIMUM DUE DATE:
Referendum Vote held:	Wednesday, June 10, 2015
<i>Village Board must meet within 30 days after certification of the favorable vote.</i>	
Village Board Meeting was held:	Wednesday, July 08, 2015
<i>Within 180 days of such meeting, the Village Board must prepare and approve a proposed elector initiated Dissolution Plan as outlined in Article 17-A, Title 3 §782(2).</i>	
<i>Village Board must prepare a Dissolution Plan and approve it by resolution on or before:</i>	
	<i>Monday, January 04, 2016</i>
Village will meet to review plan, and potentially approve it by resolution:	Wednesday, October 28, 2015
<i>No later than 5 business days after the plan is approved, the approved Dissolution Plan must be displayed on a website and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; publish a descriptive summary of the proposed Dissolution Plan <u>at least once a week, for four successive weeks</u>, and mail a certified or registered mail copy of the Dissolution Plan to the Town. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §783.</i>	
Proposed Plan must initially be posted no later than:	Monday, November 02, 2015
<i>The Village Board shall hold <u>one or more</u> public hearings on the proposed Dissolution Plan. These hearings may be held <u>no less than 35 days and no more than 90 days</u> after the proposed Dissolution Plan is approved. The public hearing or hearings shall be held on notice of at least 10 days, but not more than 20 days, published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village, and displayed on the Village website. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784.</i>	
Public Hearing held in no less than 35 days:	Thursday, December 03, 2015
Public Notice (10-20 days):	Monday, November 23, 2015
<i>Note: After the final Public Hearing, the Village Board may amend the Dissolution Plan. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3). The Village Board must approve the Final Amended Plan within 60 days of the close of the last public hearing. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3). The maximum approval date would be:</i>	Wednesday, December 09, 2015
<i>No later than 5 business days after approving the proposed Dissolution Plan, the Village Board shall cause a copy of the plan, along with a descriptive summary thereof, to be displayed and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; and displayed on a website maintained by the village, town and/or county in which the entity is located. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(4 a and b))</i>	
The Final Plan must be posted by (5 days):	Monday, December 14, 2015
Petition for Permissive Referendum must be received within 45 days after the Village Board approves the final plan:	Saturday, January 23, 2016
Petition signatures must be validated and approved:	Tuesday, February 02, 2016
Village Board must enact a resolution calling for a referendum within 30 days of Clerk's determining the validity of the petition:	Thursday, March 03, 2016
<i>Referendum Vote must be held <u>not less than 60, or more than 90 days</u> after the enactment of the resolution calling for the referendum. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(5). Notice of the Referendum shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village at least once a week, for four successive weeks. The notice shall include items outlined in Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(6).</i>	
Referendum Vote (Minimum Date) in no less than 60 days:	Tuesday, May 03, 2016
Referendum Vote (Maximum Date) scheduled in no more than 90 days:	Wednesday, June 01, 2016

Note: Timeline represents the maximum time limits. The timeline shall be updated upon any decisions or approvals reflected in the timeline.
