

**Village of Mastic Beach Voter-Initiated Dissolution Plan  
Potential Timeline**

	<b>PROPOSED TIMELINE:</b>
<b>Dissolution Petition Submitted:</b>	<b>Tuesday, August 30, 2016</b>
<i>Village Board must meet within <b>30 days</b> after petition is approved to enact a resolution calling for referendum and set a date for the vote.</i>	
<b>Special Village Board Meeting was held:</b>	<b>Thursday, September 15, 2016</b>
<i>Summary of the petition is to be published at least <u>once each week for four successive weeks</u> prior to the referendum. Referendum vote must be held within <b>60 to 90 days</b>.</i>	
<b>Referendum Vote held:</b>	<b>Wednesday, November 16, 2016</b>
<i>Village Board must meet within <b>30 days</b> after certification of the favorable vote.</i>	
<b>Village Board Meeting was held:</b>	<b>Wednesday, December 07, 2016</b>
<i><b>Within 180 days</b> of such meeting, the Village Board must prepare and approve a proposed elector initiated Dissolution Plan. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §782(2).</i>	
<b>Village will meet to review plan, and approve it by resolution:</b>	<b>Wednesday, February 01, 2017</b>
<i>No later than <b>5 business days</b> after the plan is approved, the approved Dissolution Plan must be displayed on a website and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; publish a descriptive summary of the proposed Dissolution Plan <u>at least once a week, for four successive weeks</u>, and mail a certified or registered mail copy of the Dissolution Plan to the Town. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §783.</i>	
<b>Proposed Plan must initially be posted no later than:</b>	<b>Wednesday, February 08, 2017</b>
<i>The Village Board shall hold <u>one or more</u> public hearings on the proposed Dissolution Plan. These hearings may be held <u>no less than 35 days</u> and <u>no more than 90 days</u> after the proposed Dissolution Plan is approved. The public hearing or hearings shall be held on notice of at least 10 days, but not more than 20 days, published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village, and displayed on the Village website. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784.</i>	
<b>Public Notice (10-20 days):</b>	<b>Monday, March 06, 2017</b>
<b>Public Hearing held in no less than 35 days:</b>	<b>Thursday, March 16, 2017</b>
<i>Note: After the final Public Hearing, the Village Board may amend the Dissolution Plan. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3). The Village Board must approve the Final Amended Plan <b>within 60 days</b> of the close of the last public hearing. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3).</i>	<i>Assuming a special meeting to adopt the plan.</i>
<b>Adoption 60 days from public hearing:</b>	<b>Thursday, March 30, 2017*</b>
<i>No later than <b>5 business days</b> after approving the proposed Dissolution Plan, the Village Board shall cause a copy of the plan, along with a descriptive summary thereof, to be displayed and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; and displayed on a website maintained by the village, town and/or county in which the entity is located. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(4 a and b))</i>	
<b>The Final Plan must be posted by (5 days):</b>	<b>Thursday, April 06, 2017</b>
<b>Petition for Permissive Referendum must be received within 45 days after the Village Board approves the final plan (or Dissolution may occur):</b>	<b>Sunday, May 14, 2017</b>
<b>Petition signatures must be validated and approved:</b>	<b>Tuesday, May 23, 2017</b>
<b>Village Board must enact a resolution calling for a referendum within 30 days of Clerk's validation of the petition:</b>	<b>Wednesday, June 07, 2017</b>
<i>Referendum Vote must be held <b>not less than 60</b>, or <b>more than 90 days</b> after the enactment of the resolution calling for the referendum. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(5). Notice of the Referendum shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village at least once a week, for four successive weeks. The notice shall include items outlined in Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(6).</i>	<b>Aug 7 - Sept 7, 2017</b>
<b>Referendum Vote (Minimum Date) 60 days to (Maximum) 90 days:</b>	<b>Monday, August 07, 2017</b>
<b>Dissolution Shall Occur After this Date:</b>	<b>Sunday, December 31, 2017</b>
<i>Note: The timeline shall be updated upon any decisions or approvals reflected in the timeline This is for informational purposes only. *Village Board may adopt as soon as March 16, 2017 if there are no significant changes.</i>
