<i>Within 180 days of such meeting, the Village Board must prepare and approve a proposed elector initiated Dissolution Plan. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §782(2).</i>	Assuming only 60 days	Assuming 180 days	
Village will meet to review plan, and approve it by resolution:	Monday, February 06, 2017	Wednesday, June 14, 2017	
<i>No later than 5 business days after the plan is approved, the approved Dissolution Plan must be displayed on a website and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; publish a descriptive summary of the proposed Dissolution Plan <u>at least once a week, for four successive weeks</u>, and mail a certified or registered mail copy of the Dissolution Plan to the Town. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §783.</i>			
Proposed Plan must initially be posted no later than:	Monday, February 13, 2017	Wednesday, June 21, 2017	
<i>The Village Board shall hold <u>one or more</u> public hearings on the proposed Dissolution Plan. These hearings may be held <u>no less than 35 days</u> and <u>no more than 90 days</u> after the proposed Dissolution Plan is approved. The public hearing or hearings shall be held on notice of at least 10 days, but not more than 20 days, published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village, and displayed on the Village website. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784.</i>	Assuming only 35 days	Assuming only 35 days	Assuming 90 days

Public Hearing held in no less than 35 days:	Monday, March 20, 2017	Wednesday, July 19, 2017	Tuesday, September 19, 2017
<i>Note: After the final Public Hearing, the Village Board may amend the Dissolution Plan. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3). The Village Board must approve the Final Amended Plan <u>within 60 days</u> of the close of the last public hearing. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(3)).</i>	Assuming adopted at next Village Board meeting		
Adoption 60 days from public hearing:	Wednesday, April 05, 2017	Friday, November 17, 2017	
<i>No later than 5 business days after approving the proposed Dissolution Plan, the Village Board shall cause a copy of the plan, along with a descriptive summary thereof, to be displayed and readily accessible to the public for inspection in a public place or places; and displayed on a website maintained by the village, town and/or county in which the entity is located. (See Article 17-A, Title 3 §784(4 a and b))</i>			
The Final Plan must be posted by (5 days):	Monday, April 10, 2017	Wednesday, November 22, 2017	
Petition for Permissive Referendum must be received within 45 days after the Village Board approves the final plan (or Dissolution may occur):	Monday, May 22, 2017	Monday, January 01, 2018	
Petition signatures must be validated and approved:		Thursday, January 11, 2018	
Village Board must enact a resolution calling for a referendum within 30 days of Clerk's validation of the petition:		Friday, February 09, 2018	
<i>Referendum Vote must be held <u>not less than 60</u>, or <u>more than 90 days</u> after the enactment of the resolution calling for the referendum. See Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(5). Notice of the Referendum shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village at least once a week, for four successive weeks. The notice shall include items outlined in Article 17-A, Title 3 §785(6).</i>		If there is a petition for another referendum	
Referendum Vote (Minimum Date) 60 days to (Maximum) 90 days:		Tuesday, April 10, 2018	Thursday, February 15, 2018
Dissolution May Occur After this Date:		Thursday, February 15, 2018
